



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During the last week, average daily rainfall over Sri Lanka was 2.2 mm and hydro catchment areas received 6.6 mm.
Highest average rainfall of 6.2 mm/day received in Western region.



From 4 - 10 Jul, up to 15 m/s of northwest-westerly winds were at 850 mb (1.5 km).
During 14 - 20 Jul, up to 15 m/s of northwest-westerly winds are expected at 850 mb (1.5 km).



Monitored Sea & Land Temp

Sea surface temperature around Sri Lanka was 0.25 - 1.5°C above normal.
Average maximum land temperature ranged from 29 -32°C and minimum ranged from 24 -25°C with a drop in the hills.

### Pacific sea state: July 10, 2023

El Nino Mode has set in now according to NOAA since 8<sup>th</sup> of June. Equatorial sea surface temperatures (SSTs) are above average across the east central and eastern Pacific Ocean mid-July. El Niño conditions are expected to gradually strengthen into the Northern Hemisphere winter 2023-24.

### Indian Ocean State

Sea surface temperature around Sri Lanka was near normal to the country in 20<sup>th</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2023. A positive Dipole Mode has set in across the Indian Ocean since 8<sup>th</sup> of June.

**Rainfall:** During the last two weeks, there had been heavy rainfall over the following areas: Kegalle, Nuwara Eliya

Daily Average Rainfall in the Met stations for previous week of  $(5^{th} July - 12^{th} July) = 2.2 \text{ mm}$ Maximum Daily Rainfall: 47.5 mm & Minimum Daily Rainfall: 0.0 mm.

*Wind:* Northwest-westerly winds prevailed in the sea area and around the island last week. *Temperatures:* The temperature anomalies were near normal for the country driven by the warm SST's.

### **Predictions**

**Rainfall:** During the next week ( $13^{th}$  July –  $19^{th}$  July), fairly heavy rainfall ( $\geq 55$  mm) is predicted for the Sabaragamuwa, Southern, Western and Central provinces and less rainfall is predicted for the rest of the country.

**Temperatures:** The temperature will remain above normal for some parts of the Northern, Eastern, Uva, North Central, and Southern provinces and below normal for some parts of the Central province during 14<sup>th</sup> July – 20<sup>th</sup> July.

**Teleconnections:** A positive Dipole Mode has set in across the Indian Ocean since 8<sup>th</sup> of June. MJO shall slightly enhance the rainfall during 13<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> July for Sri Lanka.

*Seasonal Precipitation:* The precipitation forecast for the July-August-September, 2023 season shows above normal precipitation for the country.


#### Weekly Rainfall Monitoring

The following figures show the total satellite observed rainfall in the last week in Sri Lanka. The figure in the left is the total 7-day rainfall from NOAA Climate Prediction Center (CPC) Unified Precipitation Analysis and the figure in the right is the total 7-day rainfall from CPC RFE 2.0 Satellite Rainfall Estimates. The bottom two figures are the respective anomalies.








#### Monthly Rainfall Monitoring


The figure in the left shows the average observed rainfall in the previous month. The rainfall anomaly in the previous month is shown in the figure to the right. The brown color in the anomaly figure shows places which received less rainfall than the historical average while the green color shows places with above average rainfall. Darker shades show higher magnitudes in rainfall



The figure in the top-left shows the total rainfall in the past 30 days from CPC Unified Precipitation Analysis while the figure in the top-right shows the total rainfall for the same period from RFE 2.0 Satellite Rainfall Estimates. The bottom two figures show the percentage of rainfall received in the past 30 days compared to normal rainfall in this period.




CPC Unified Gauge 30-Day Percent of Normal Rainfall (%)



















#### Weekly Wind Monitoring


#### Weekly Average SST Anomalies


#### Optimum Interpolated Sea Surface Temperature Anomaly in the Indian Ocean from NOAA CPC












#### Madden Julian Oscillation (MJO) related Outgoing Longwave Radiation (OLR) Forecast

The Outgoing Longwave Radiation (OLR) is a proxy for rainfall. This can be used to identify convective rain clouds based on the MJO phase. Violet and Blue shading indicates enhanced tropical weather and Orange shading indicates suppressed conditions. The following figure shows the forecasts of MJO associated anomolous OLR for the next 15 days from the Constructed Analogue (CA) model forecasts.




OLR prediction of MJO-related anomalies using CA model reconstraction by RMM1 & RMM2 (12 Jul 2023)






Weekly mean vector wind total prediction from the GFS model at 850 mb (left) and 700 mb (right) levels. (from NOAA CPC)



GFS 850mb week1 Mean Vector Wind Total (m/s) Period: 18z14Jul2023 - 18z20Jul2023



IRI Multi-Model Probability Forecast for Precipitation for

Following is the latest seasonal precipitation and temperature prediction for the next 3 months by the IRI. The color shading indicates the probability of the most dominant tercile -- that is, the tercile having the highest forecast probability. The color bar alongside the map defines these dominant tercile probability levels. The upper side of the color bar shows the colors used for increasingly strong probabilities when the dominant tercile is the above-normal tercile, while the lower side shows likewise for the below-normal tercile. The gray color indicates an enhanced probability for the near-normal tercile (nearly always limited to 40%).
