Masters in Development Practice (MDP) at the University of Peradeniya

Information for Foreign Students

A new Masters in Development Practice (MDP) shall be launched at the University of Peradeniya in collaboration with the FECT, Columbia University, Open Universities and others starting in October 2011. The program is hosted by the Department of Economics at the University of Peradeniya.

Student Visa

A student visa gives residency rights. Student visas could be issued to persons who have registered as a student in the University of Peradeniya.

The visa fee is waived if the Ministry of Higher Education recommends a free visa.

You may obtain a tourist visa initially and convert it to student visa once you have registered for the MDP at University of Peradeniya.

Tourist Visa

There are two categories of visit visas to Sri Lanka – tourist and business. A tourist visa is issued for a short period of time. **Visa fee is approximately \$40**

However once the prospective student is admitted to the University of Peradeniya, tourist visa can be converted into a student visa easily by visiting Ministry of Higher Education (http://www.mohe.gov.lk/) and Department of Immigration and Emigration.

Requirements to apply for the Tourist Visa

Sri Lanka Immigration and Emigration may grant or issue a visa to you if -

- I. Sri Lanka Immigration & Emigration is satisfied that you are suitable to enter Sri Lanka.
- II. Sri Lanka Immigration & Emigration approves the purpose for which you are entering Sri Lanka. (Once you have selected to follow MDP, University of Peradeniya will issue a student identity to process visa)
- III. You hold a passport valid for a minimum period of six months from the date you arrive in Sri Lanka.
- IV. Sri Lanka Immigration & Emigration is satisfied that you have adequate funds for your maintenance whilst in Sri Lanka and for the payment of your return passage to the country which issued your passport.
- V. You are in possession of a written assurance (ticket) to return to the country of domicile or a visa to the next country of destination if you are a visit visa holder.
